



Launch of New Packages & Tariff Changes

24 April 2019 - JSC Silknet ("Silknet" or the "Company"), a leading Georgian telecommunications operator, announced the launch of certain new packages and changes to certain existing offers. The majority of the changes are planned to become effective from 20 May, 2019.

Following the introduction of the new tariffs, Silknet's subscribers will be afforded with the opportunity to consume more content through higher mobile data allowances and/or fixed broadband bandwidth.
